## Moves into GA Aerobatics Arena with XtremeAir Acquisition

In August 2018 Skyleader officially took over the German aerobatic aircraft manufacturer XtremeAir.

Czech Republic-based Skyleader's portfolio includes Zall Jihlavan Airplanes with its production of all-metal ultralight airplanes and the Zall Letov Simulators branch which is specialized in a wide spectrum of flight simulators.

Skyleader also produces and distributes carbon/glass-composite ultralight aircraft and now with more than 20 years of experience in the aircraft market is expanding into the GA aerobatic market with this latest purchase.

With new ideas and developments XtremeAir is planning to broaden its product portfolio. Besides the current production of the high-performance XA42/XA41 aerobatic airplanes, it plans to launch the new XA22 in 2019.

The XA22 Aerobatic Trainer aircraft will be designed for basic and advanced aerobatics, addressing the requirements of ambitious

pilots, Aerobatic Flight Schools, as well as Airshow Formation Teams. In addition, XtremeAir plans to develop a more comfortable Gran Turismo variant that combines the remarkable capabilities of the XA42 in terms of range, speed, ergonomics and maneuvering characteristics with the comfort of an autopilot, IFR instrumentation and other options for an XtremeAir touring aircraft with aerobatic capabilities.

Moreover, XtremeAir continues to pursue the development of an Aerobatic Simulator which will be equipped with state-of-the-art VR Technology thanks to an existing collaboration with Zall Letov Simulátory.

Years of experience in building lightweight aircraft combined with a great international network will lead into combined synergy effects which allow Skyleader and XtremeAir to have a positive outlook towards the future.
