THE ACROBATIC PLANES OF XTREMEAIR HAVE MADE THE COMPANY A LEADER AMONG ACROBATIC MACHINES AND WE KNOW THE CZECH SKY BECAUSE THE FLYING BULLS ACROBATIC TEAM CURRENTLY DAZZLES THERE.

That's why we were pleasantly surprised by the report that the group SKYLEADER and Zall, which includes Zall Jihlavan Airplanes in Jihlava and Zall Letov Simulátory in Olomouc, has announced the completion of the process to acquire the German company XtremeAir, which will expand the brand and production portfolio of Skyleader to include a line of acrobatic planes.

At present XtremeAir produces the acrobatic machines XA 41 and XA 42 at a newly built factory in the German city of Magdeburg-Cochstedt.

The successful completion of the transformation will see the XtremeAir product portfolio grow to include the acrobatic training

XA22, which provides basic and related acrobatic exercises with the full support of both individual competitors and complete teams in the individual categories of acrobatic competitions.

In view of the extraordinary aerodynamic and maneuvering characteristics of planes produced by XtremeAir, a version of the fast passenger plane of the Gran Turismo class equipped with autopilot and IFR avionics will be included in the offer.

The strategy of Skyleader is to further expand not only its portfolio of planes in the UL/LSA categories but also in the General Aviation category and last but not least to develop in 2019, in cooperation with Zall Letov Simulátory based in



Olomouc, the newly acquired XtremeAir modern acrobatic simulator using the most advanced components of VR.

The acquisition of XtremeAir under the wings of Skyleader and expansion of the product line should bring future changes to the Czech acrobatic sky. Our plans are big and we will acquaint you with them over time on the website of Flying Review.

Those interested in XtremeAir planes will have the singular opportunity to get to know one and try it during the European Championships 2018 at the Unlimited aerial acrobatics in Jindřich Hradec, which will take place 1-9 September.
